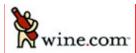

## Five Tips

#### 5 Tips for Mastering Your Domain... on the Web

Whether you are starting your business or thinking about growing it, you need a web site that can be easily found by your customers and by potential new business, and one that will turn up quickly during Web search. NAFE member **Jo Belanger**, the website designer for NAFE, offers five tips for establishing an effective domain name for your business.

- 1. Register your domain name now. Even if you don't plan to develop a website for a while, get your name registered as soon as you can while it is still available.
- 2. Try for the .com. We do live in a dot com world and although other top level domains (the letters after the dot) are available such as .biz or .info, people still think .com when it comes to the web.
- Don't despair if your first choice for a .com name is already taken. There are alternatives. If your company name is ABC Rentals you may find that even though abcrentals.com may already be taken, abc-rentals.com may still be available.
- 4. Try for keywords in your domain name. In the above example ABC Rentals is a natural because rentals is a good keyword. But if your company name is Smith and Smith LLP., using smithandsmith.com may lessen your chances of coming up on a keyword search. smithandsmithlaw.com may be a better choice.
- 5. Use a reputable domain name registrar. You can get a domain name on the cheap, but you want to be sure that you will get good service from your registrar.

Go Daddy is cheap, and offers a lot of online tools for managing your domainalthough phone support is not their strong suit.

Network Solutions is the original registrar and is pricey but supportive.

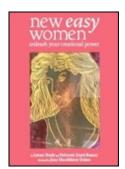
Register.com is a well-established registrar, but very pricey. You can save money by registering your domain for a number of years at a time - some registrars go up to 10 years.

Once you've taken care of the domain name business, you can then find a web designer and hosting service to make your website live and serve as a good ambassador for your company.

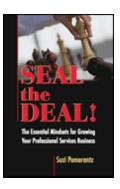
